For the 2021/2022 school year, we are permitting Patrol Supervisors to show the training videos to their Patrollers **only** when practical training will be facilitated by the Program partner. Practical training cannot be provided by Patrol Supervisors. The list below provides your additional roles and responsibilities as you act as a Patrol Supervisor and will be assisting with training this year. For additional support with any program related questions, please contact your Program Partner.

- Ensure School permission forms are signed and collected before training
 - Arrange time and location for practical components to be facilitated by Program partner
 - Show entire Patrol team the Training Videos that apply to your school program (foot, bus, both) *This must be completed prior to practical components*
 - Ensure practical training is completed by Program partner and follows safety protocols
 - Administer and grade exams, and retain them for remainder of the school year
- If time allows, review the [Training Videos](#) prior to showing them to your Patrol team.

- *Exam:* Exams are available in English and French for either program type. Patrollers are required to score 75% or above to pass the exam. If the Patroller is not successful in their first try, the exam can be re-administered until they are successful. An answer key is available on the Google drive.
- *Letter to Parents:* This letter can accompany your school’s permission form to explain what the program is about.
